Only hospitals that perform well clinically with regard to heart care measures of mortality and readmission reported to Medicare, and also have a high Hospital Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (HCAHPS) recommendation score, a measure that is very important to women in choosing a hospital, are selected. **San Antonio Regional Hospital is recognized for ranking among the top 2% in the nation for Heart Care.**

San Antonio Regional Hospital earned the **Best Hospitals for Cancer Care Award** because it met the comprehensive cancer care standards of the American College of Surgeons Commission on Cancer, as well as achieving excellence in clinical performance with regard to cancer care measures and for their high patient recommendation rate. It also provides comprehensive care with a full range of diagnostic and

treatment services. San Antonio Regional Hospital is recognized for ranking among the top 6% in the nation for Cancer Care.

San Antonio Regional Hospital has earned the **Best Hospitals for Orthopedics Award** by offering a full range of diagnostic and specialty services for patients with injuries or conditions of the muscles, bones, or joints. Apart from being a comprehensive facility, the hospital has high patient recommendation and recovery ratings, and low adverse surgical event scores. **San Antonio Regional Hospital is recognized for ranking among the top 7% in the nation for Orthopedics.**

San Antonio Regional Hospital earned the Best Hospitals for Stroke Care Award by meeting high standards for stroke care including holding a Stroke Center Certification by the Joint Commission (JC) and/or Det Norske Veritas (DNV). Hospitals that meet the stroke center certification requirement, must then meet or exceed the following performance measures from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS): Hospitals must also score in the top 80% of all hospitals in the percent of patients receiving Head CT scan results within 45 minutes, cannot have received a rating of Worse than the National Rate for the Deaths from Serious Treatable Complications measure, and have a patient recommendation score greater than or equal to the national average. San Antonio Regional Hospital is recognized for ranking among the top 9% in the nation for Stroke Care.

San Antonio Regional Hospital earned the **Best Hospitals for Emergency Care Award** by having an above average patient recommendation rate and consistently ranking in the top 25-50 percent of the hospitals reporting on their emergency department's performance to CMS. The five measures CMS publicly reports relate primarily to the amount of time taken in the ER such as time spent in the ER, time to admission, percentage of patients who leave before being seen, timely care for stroke symptoms, and adherence to quality bundled care for sepsis, and are weighted according to the priorities of women surveyed. **San Antonio Regional Hospital is recognized for ranking among the top 10% percent in the nation for Emergency Care.**

Founder and CEO of the Women's Choice Award, Delia Passi, emphasized that San Antonio Regional Hospital truly delivers on the care that matters most to women, who make over 90% of healthcare decisions.
