#### · Which departments will I shadow?

 Students can shadow in the pharmacy, laboratory, urgent care, operating room, cardiology, maternity and many more departments!

## · How long is the program?

- 4 weeks, Monday through Friday.
- Shifts can vary, but the earliest shift starts at 6am and the latest shift ends at 2pm.
