- **What is the Clinical Shadowing Program?**
 - The Clinical Shadowing Program provides juniors in high school with an immersive experience observing different hospital departments.

- **Where and how can I apply?**
 - When the application is open, you can apply [here](#).
- **When are applications open?**
 - Each application window will be listed when applications are being accepted.
 - You must apply before the closing date listed.
- **Who is eligible to participate in CSP?**
 - Juniors in High School
- **How much does it cost to participate in CSP?**
 - There is no fee to participate.
- **What locations are available for shadowing?**
 - San Antonio Regional Hospital and Urgent Care Centers
- **Which departments will I shadow?**
 - Students can shadow in the pharmacy, laboratory, urgent care, operating room, cardiology, maternity and many more departments!
- **How long is the program?**
 - 4 weeks, Monday through Friday.
 - Shifts can vary, but the earliest shift starts at 6am and the latest shift ends at 2pm.
- **Can these hours be used as volunteer hours?**
 - Yes
- **Does this program guarantee a spot as a volunteer at San Antonio Regional Hospital?**
 - No, the volunteer program is separate.
- **If I am a college student, can I apply for CSP?**
 - We only accept Juniors in high school. If you have an interest in volunteering, please visit our volunteering page at sarh.org.
- **Do students get to interact with patients?**
 - No, students do not have direct patient contact, care or interaction.
