

How would you feel if you gave someone a gift, and they didn't thank you for it?

In a way, it was that exact dilemma that resulted in the creation of the Living Legacy Society.

In April of 1991, San Antonio Hospital Foundation received \$5,000 from the estate of Dorothy Mae Thompson of Oakland, California.

There was one problem, though. No one in the Foundation remembered Mrs. Thompson. Who could she be? Because we didn't know about the legacy, there

was no opportunity to thank Mrs. Thompson for her generosity. As it turned out, Mrs. Thompson had once lived

in the area, used the hospital, and was pleased with the care she received. But, it would have been nice to be able to thank Mrs. Thompson in person

The Living Legacy Society was born from that experience. Now we try to build closer relationships with special people like Mrs. Thompson – people who are grateful for San Antonio Community Hospital – who want to make sure the hospital is here to take care of their family and friends and others in our community for years to come.

How CAN You LEAVE A LEGACY? It's easy. Even if you don't have appreciated property

or a large savings account, you can leave your mark on the world with a meaningful legacy that will benefit San Antonio Community Hospital.

Gifts that Provide You with Income for Life You can transfer appreciated assets, such as stock

or property, to the Foundation and retain a fixed or variable life income. You avoid capital gains tax and receive a current income tax deduction After receiving a life income, the principle passes to the Foundation.

Leave a Legacy with a Will or a Trust You can name the Foundation in your will, living trust, or as beneficiary of your retirement plan.

A Legacy of Life Insurance You can name the Foundation as owner and beneficiary of an existing life insurance policy you no longer need, and deduct the cash value,

or create a new policy and deduct future premiums.

Estate Planning Gifts You can transfer assets that pay an income to the Foundation for a period of years, with the principal passing to your heirs at reduced gift or estate tax cost.

Retaining a Life Estate In Your Home

You can give your personal residence or other $property-even\ a\ farm-to\ the\ Foundation,\ while$ retaining lifetime use of that property and receiving substantial tax benefits right now.
